Traveling to South Africa and Jamaica to carry out mission work, as well as facilitating a prayer workshop at an International Women's Conference held in the Bahamas were high spots for Linda. She has served as the Prayer Leader at many prayer bootcamps as a part of the Lydia Circle for Christian Business and Professional Women and a Prayer Leader at her home church in the city of Detroit. "More things are wrought by prayer than this world dreams of" is a favorite quote of Linda Fegins by a prayer warrior.
